The theme is to be based on the dangers of drinking and driving. Cash prizes will be awarded to the winners, with a cash prize to the overall winning school. There will be two age groups; 11 and under, and 12- 18. Cash prizes will be awarded for the best animations in each age group.

1<sup>st</sup> Prize    £150  
2<sup>nd</sup> Prize    £100  
3<sup>rd</sup> Prize    £50

A prize of £300 will also be awarded to the School/College of the first prize-winner in each age group. Winning animations may be shown on the IOGT England and Wales website.

The running time of the animation should be no less than forty-five seconds and no more than ninety seconds in length. The animation can be recorded using any visual recording device, e.g. camcorder or mobile phone, and be able to be sent via e-mail.
